

IAAAF Flight Training Scholarship

Two \$1000.00 flight training scholarships are available to help pay for flight training for the acquisition of any airman certificate or rating issued by the Federal Aviation Administration. These will be awarded by the IAAAF at the Aviation Appreciation Day at the Fairbanks International Airport.

Eligibility Requirements:

Have passed a written test for the certificate or rating sought.

Have a specific and realistic goal for advancement in aviation with the intent to stay in Alaska.

Flight currency: applicant must be a current and flight qualified pilot or student pilot with a current medical certificate or equivalent.

Application Process

Submit an application package no later than April 30, 2013 to:

If selected as a finalist, successfully complete an interview.

Application package must contain:

A cover letter-introducing yourself with a statement that you intend to use these funds only for the purpose of flight training.

Copies of your pilot certificates, *the first and last pages of your logbook*, medical certificate or driver's license and a copy of the written test results for the certificate or rating sought.

Three non-aviation character references.

Applicant's essay: 500 words describing yourself; your activities in aviation to date; your goals and opportunities ahead; and how you have financed your flight training.
